Colonel Mitch Neurock is the Air Reserve Component Advisor to The Judge Advocate General. In this capacity, he provides senior-level advice to The Judge Advocate General on all matters concerning Air Force Reserve and Air National Guard programs.

Born at Kindley AFB, Bermuda, Colonel Neurock earned a Bachelor of Arts from Rice University, and also studied international relations at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. He graduated from Washington & Lee University School of Law in 1992. While in law school, Colonel Neurock earned his Air Force commission through the One Year Commissioning Program.



Colonel Neurock's active duty career included assignments at Whiteman AFB, Missouri, at Izmir Air Station, Turkey, and at the Government Trial and Appellate Counsel Division in Washington, DC. Upon leaving active duty in 1998, Colonel Neurock continued his service in the Air Force Reserve, first as an Appellate Government Counsel and later at wing- and headquarters-level offices in Texas and Louisiana. Colonel Neurock returned to active duty and reported to his current position in September 2009.

In his civilian life, Colonel Neurock is a federal prosecutor with the United States Attorney's Office in Houston, Texas.
